

Curved Corner Individual





Step 1:

See Figure 1A

Lay side post on floor with pre - drilled holes facing in.

Step 2:

See Figure 1B

Attach bottom shelf to the side post, by sliding the bolt at the end of the post through the hole on the shelf. (Note: be sure that all rails on the shelf are facing same direction.)

Step 3:


Insert Bolt Cap into the bottom shelf and tighten with the wrench included in the hardware pack.

Step 4

Repeat steps 1 through 3 for the rest of the side posts and for the top shelf.



"This side faces floor if stacking"

"STACKABLE OPTION"

When stacking racks, the "Top Shelf" of the Bottom Rack must be flipped 180 Deg so the rails face down. This applies only to the "Top Shelf of the Bottom Rack" This is to be done before attaching to posts.

Step 5

Attach back post to the top and bottom using the Bolt Caps as shown.





Step 6

See Figure 3

Insert the shelf supports into the holes provided.

(Note: Be sure the shelf supports are all in the same hole on each post, so the shelf will be able to sit evenly.)



Step 7

Insert shelf into rack.

Placing the shelf on the shelf supports with the pointed side up. (This will allow the shelf supports to fall into the holes on the bottom of the shelf.)




Step 8

Repeat steps 5 and 6 for the remaining shelves. (Be sure to space the shelves evenly.)

Installation Instructions

After the wine rack is completely assembled, attach the velcro to the four corners of the wine rack. (Two at the top and two at the bottom.) Then lean wine rack against the wall and lightly draw a line on the wall marking the top of the rack. After mark has been made then peel off the other side of the velcro and line up the rack with the mark that was made on the wall. Push the wine rack against the wall firmly to secure.


Note: After wine rack is mounted to the wall, use the angle bracket (included in the hardware package) to secure racks tight;y to the wall for additional support.




Angle bracket

POSITION RACK AND BRACKET OVER PLASTIC SCREW ANCHORS. SECURE RACK TO WALL WITH 1" - #8 SCREW. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.

TOP VIEW OF ATTACHING ANGLE BRACKETS.




SIDE VIEW



Side to Side Connection

NOTE

SRS IND is demonstrated in the picture. The same method applies to all SRS racking.



Peel off one side of the 1/2" Velcro and attach it to the four corners of the first rack.
Peel off the other side of the Velcro and attach it to the other rack.
Press firmly together and allow 1 hour for setup time.

Top to Bottom Connection

Peel off one side of the 1/2" Velcro and attach it to the top shelf of the first rack.
Peel off the other side of the Velcro and attach the other rack.
